

## Transportation provided by Ski-doo & Komatik

### Ski-doo

- The Ski-doo is to be driven at a speed not exceeding 20 km in the community and not exceeding 40 km over harbor ice and trails
- LIHC will provide helmets to children whose parents have requested it.

### Komatik/Sled

- A staff member is always to accompany the child or children in the Komatik /sled while they are being transported.
- Children are to remain seated at all times while being transported.
- Infants and toddlers are to be securely held by an adult while being transported.
- Komatik/sled may be padded using 4 inches thick protective padding so as to provide adequate protection.
- Use of helmets:
  - Children age two years and over may wear helmets designed for use with snowmobiles when traveling by snowmobile, Komatik/sled. The helmet shall fit securely and be unable to slip forward exposing the neck or backward exposing the forehead.
  - Where a child's development indicates that the lightest snowmobile helmet available (currently 2.5lbs) may cause injury to the child's neck, a hockey helmet with face shield shall be worn. As soon as a child's neck can support the 2.5 lb snowmobile helmet safely, such a helmet may be worn.
  - Children may use face shields: Face shields can be attached to both hockey helmets and snowmobile helmets to protect the children from the elements as well as provide protection from any sudden impact. (Face shields are clear, see through attachments) .
  - Children are encouraged to wear protective clothing such as a hat or face mask underneath the helmet for protection from the cold.
