TRC – Virtual Quilt

Call to Communities

Pauktuutit is starting a new project as a national commemoration of Inuit Residential Schools experience and legacy. The project, entitled “TRC - Virtual Quilt” is a project for communities that are interested in producing an art piece that reflects the Inuit experience of Residential Schools. The original art piece will remain in the community where it was produced as a lasting commemoration of those experiences.

Inuit women are the focus of this project but anyone who attended an Inuit Residential School or Federal Hostel – or have been impacted directly or inter-generationally can be involved in the project. The final outcomes of this project are intended to document and preserve the legacy of these experiences and to help begin a dialogue of reconciliation and healing with all Canadians.

Photos and videos will document the process of creating the art piece to become part of a ‘virtual quilt’ on the Pauktuutit website. Each participating community will be provided with materials and will document their process with photographs. The final documentary will include voices and artistic expressions of the participants through video and still photography.
