Women often eave alone.

## **Hoping to find a safe place** in a large city where no one knows them with the intention of eventually bringing their children with them.





Other women reported **running away with their children**, sometimes passing through many destinations before reaching big cities.

In all situations, women said they had experienced heavy trauma, guilt, and feelings of failure as a parent.
