 Over the past year, Pauktuutit has continued to work with colleagues on a national committee to contribute to the development of a Federal Early Childhood Development Strategy. A priority of this work is to strengthen linkages with Inuit communities including urban Inuit in regards to their early childhood development needs.

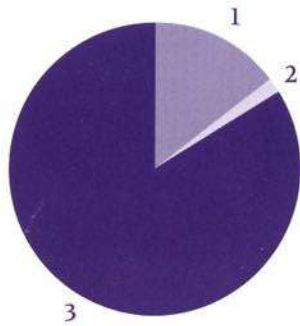
• **Respite for Inuit Family Caregivers**
 Pauktuutit has developed and is implementing an Inuit-specific strategy to support family caregivers in the North. An Advisory Committee comprised of representatives from across the Arctic. Generously supported by the J. W. McConnell Family Foundation, is guiding the project – to provide a greater voice for caregivers, ensure they receive the support they require, and increase public awareness of respite options.

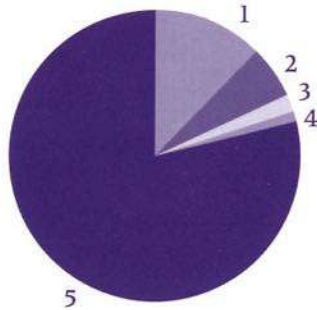
Where the Money Comes From

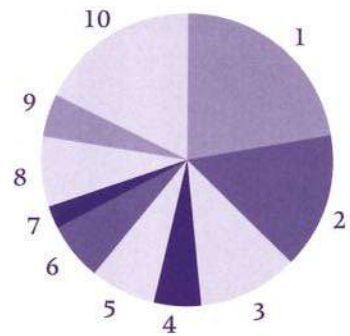
