When and Where

This website is for an organization in Canada called Pauktuutit Inuit Women of Canada. The project is called I'm Happy Because I'm Safe – Phase 2. These pages were created in 2014.

Why

The Internet connects people and ideas. Some people are good and some are bad, and ideas can be good and bad too. As you grow up, you learn. We want to make sure you know of the good things and are warned of the bad things, so you can make good decisions for yourself.

Tips

Going online is easy. Being safe online means being safe in public.

1. Check with a parent or adult you trust before going to a new website.
2. Don't talk to people you don't know.
3. Don't click on things you don't know.
4. If something happens you don't like, tell a parent or adult you trust.
