INTRODUCTION

Inuit people have been living in the Arctic for thousands of years. Inuit are the original inhabitants of the Arctic region and have a unique relationship with the land and its resources. Inuit are a distinct cultural group with their own language, traditions, and way of life. Inuit are also a minority group in many countries, including Canada, the United States, Greenland, and Russia.

METHOD

The Inuit Tapiriit Kanatami (ITK) is a national organization representing the Inuit in Canada. ITK has conducted research and advocacy work on behalf of Inuit for over 40 years. In 2010, ITK initiated a project to develop a national sexual health strategy for Inuit. The project involved a consultative process with Inuit from across Canada, including Inuit from northern communities, urban centers, and Inuit living abroad. The project also involved input from Inuit organizations, government agencies, and academic institutions.

RECOMMENDED POLICIES AND PRACTICES INCLUDE:

- 1. Promoting comprehensive sexual education for all ages.
- 2. Providing accessible and culturally appropriate sexual health services.
- 3. Addressing the unique challenges faced by Inuit in remote and northern communities.
- 4. Encouraging Inuit to take an active role in decision-making about their sexual health.
- 5. Supporting Inuit to maintain and strengthen their traditional knowledge and practices related to sexual health.

NATIONAL INUIT SEXUAL HEALTH STRATEGY

The National Inuit Sexual Health Strategy is a framework for improving sexual health outcomes for Inuit. The strategy is based on the principles of self-determination, cultural competency, and social determinants of health. The strategy aims to address the unique needs and challenges faced by Inuit in maintaining and promoting sexual health. The strategy includes recommendations for policy, program, and service development.
